- Deadline March 2, 2023
- Support for students w/ visas

Pass all your classes!

- Ds or better for graduation
- Cs or better for college

Take SAT/ACT if necessary

(not required UC/CSU/Community)

Continue to be actively involved in activities outside of the classroom (sports/clubs/volunteering/work)




