- 1. Social Security Number*

- 3. Alien Registration Number, if student has one.
- 4. Financial Records from 2018, if student had an income.
- 5. List of schools student has applied to or will apply to.
- 6. FSA ID (FASFA only)

*Note: The SSN provided through the Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals is not for use on the FAFSA. Please attend a workshop for guidance on the Dream Application.

PARENTS

- 1. Social Security Number On either application, if parent does not have one, enter zeros.
- 2. FSA ID (FASFA only)
- 3. Financial Record from 2018, if parent(s) had an income, including:
- Tax forms- 1040 (A, EZ) & W-2
- Records of untaxed income, such as child support received, interest income
- Bank statements
